

OPERATION FELIX - HEINRICH



Axis & Allies Global 1940 & 1943 House Rules Expansions

From the round when Germany controls *Smolensk*, *Bryansk* and *Western Ukraine*, Germany may begin **Operation Felix-Heinrich** – the invasion of *Spain*.



- No German units may *Blitz* through *Spain* to either *Portugal* or *Gibraltar* during the German invasion of *Spain*.



Follow this procedure:

- From the start of Germany's turn, the German player must control *Smolensk*, *Bryansk* and *Western Ukraine*.
- In the *Purchase & Repair New Units* phase the German player announces that **Operation Felix-Heinrich** will begin this turn.

- No combat will occur against the Spanish units that represents the *Spanish Defense Force*. These Spanish units will initially be ignored – but will remain “active” in *Spain*.



- The German player immediately pays 6 IPC to the bank for “violating” the neutrality of *Spain*.
- German *Paratrooper* units cannot attack *Spain* by air during this invasion.
- The German player must move at least 6 *Infantry* units plus at least 4 *Panzer* units into *Spain* during the *Combat Movement* phase.

- When the German *Combat Movement* phase is over, the German player takes control of *Spain* and corrects the *Expanded National Production Chart* and increases the German IPC Level by 2 IPC.

- Germany now controls *Spain* in the same way as any other German controlled territory.



- *Spain* is no longer considered *Strict Neutral* once it has been occupied by Germany.

United Kingdom countermeasures:

From the round when Germany controls *Spain* – and on any future round – the United Kingdom can invade *Portugal*.



Follow this procedure:

- In the *Purchase & Repair New Units* phase the United Kingdom player announces that *Portugal* will be invaded by UK forces – and immediately pays 3 IPC to the bank for violating the neutrality of *Portugal*.

- The invasion of *Portugal* must take place from *Sea Zone 91* and/or *104*.
- The Portuguese units will defend against the UK invasion forces.
- The *Expanded National Production Chart* is corrected in favor of United Kingdom if the invasion was successful.



- UK *Paratrooper* units cannot attack *Portugal* by air during this invasion.



The Spanish Defense Force:

- The *Spanish Defense Force* cannot move – but it can defend.
- If *Spain* is attacked by any Allied units the *Spanish Defense Force* will defend against the invaders.
- The units in the *Spanish Defense Force* defend in the same way as any other units.
- The *Spanish Defense Force* will defend against any Allied attack whether or not there are any Axis units present in *Spain*.

Note:

Other *Strict Neutral* territories/Nations are not affected by the German invasion of *Spain* or the UK invasion of *Portugal*.
